

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 19, 2016
7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Thursday, May 19, 2016 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present with the exception of the Mayor who gave prior notice. Also present was the Solicitor Dan Long and Engineer Mark Basehore.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Saxton to adopt the minutes of May 04, 2016 meeting with all Council voting aye.

Resolution 2016:81 was not needed since there were no maintenance liens.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt Resolution 2016:82 to authorize to dispose of the 1990 GMC Dump Truck VIN IGDP70IY3LVS08696 as junk. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt Resolution 2016:83 for accepting the Performance Bond by Jerry & Son Excavation for the Misc. Intersections Project. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman DePrince to introduce Ordinance 2016:06 for the 2016 Bond Ordinance. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Councilman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt Resolution 2016:84 to appoint temporary part time laborers for DPW. They were Jason Bullock, James Sayles, and Kody Reilly. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Committee Reports

Councilman DePrince stated he spoke with the Lt. Governor about the White Horse Pike DOT project. He stated there was an EMS employee injured coming down a stairway with a patient. He also attended a County Fire Chief's Meeting two weeks ago with Chief Wolf.

Councilman Whalen stated the Administrator and Treasurer were beginning to cross train.

Councilman Whalen made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt

Resolution 2016:85 to appoint Shelley Strehle as Deputy Tax Collector for the borough. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Councilwoman Bonamassa stated the website links have been reviewed to be functioning.

Councilman Krause spoke about the recreation meeting which took place last week getting ready for the July 4th event. He reviewed the laser show he has been working on in place of the fireworks. It will take place July 1 at Yellin School in Stratford. There is a meeting this Tuesday in Somerdale.

Councilwoman Martz stated the rabies clinic will be moved this year to the community center outside since parking and access is better. She spoke about the issues with the two homes on Ashland Avenue.

Councilman Saxton stated he issued a memo to confirm all community center reservations and usage would now go through the administrator. He is still working on the air conditioner for the police office. He will be updating the contents of the first aid kit at the community center.

The Engineer spoke about the design work beginning for the NJDOT Madison Avenue Project.

The Solicitor stated he had two items for executive session, one for personnel and one for legal.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Krause to open the meeting to the public. All Council voted aye.

No one from the public spoke.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to close the meeting to the public with all Council voting aye.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Saxton to authorize the bills be paid. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Saxton to enter Closed Session Resolution 2016:80 with all Council voting aye.

A motion was made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to come out of Closed Session with all Council voting aye.

A motion was made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman DePrince to appoint Megan Giordano as Substitute Tax Collector at a rate of \$30.00 per hour. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Whalen to adopt Resolution 2016:87 to authorize the two deputy court administrators as signers to all municipal court banking accounts with 1st Colonial National Bank. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Saxton to adjourn the meeting with all Council voting aye.
